

PAST PERFORMANCE

Records the horses individual performance in each race.

- (A)** Betting Number, Horses Name, Saddle Cloth Colour, Owners Silks, Jockeys Name & current year's statistics. (Total number of starts, Wins, Seconds, Thirds & Win %)
- (B)** Indicates medication being used:
 - L - Lasix
 - L1 - first time lasix
 - LO - used lasix last start, but not today
- (C)** Horses Personal Information:
 - Colour
 - Sex
 - Sire's (father) Name
 - Dam's (mother) Name
 - Owner
 - Breeder (Province or State)
 - Trainer's Name & Statistics (Total # of starts, Wins, Seconds, Thirds & Win %)
- (D)** Morning Line Odds:
 - Handicappers Prediction
 - Jockey's Assigned Weight
- (E)** Horse's Statistics - total # of races, 1st, 2nd, 3rd place finishes for current year, last year, lifetime, lifetime at Woodbine only.
- (F)** Horses Statistics for Race Courses - total # of 1st, 2nd, 3rd place finisher for
 - Dirt (fast track)
 - Dirt (wet track)
 - Turf (all)
- (G)** Race Number, track name, track conditions, distance ran, surface (other than dirt).
- (H)** Interval fractions & finish time of horse leading.
- (I)** Age restriction- is .3 year old & upward
- (J)** Abbreviated Conditions of the Race - see race header for complete description, Maidens (never won a race) But can be claimed for \$20,000.
- (K)** Track Master Early Pace Figures (77) & Speed Rating (69) refer to sidebar.
- (N)** Post position/total number & horses in race.
- (L)** Pre-race preparation: Date, Track name, track condition, time, ranking amongst all horses working that distance on that day. (called workouts)
- (M)** Position throughout the race and final placing behind the leader
- (O)** Jockey's name, horse's medication, apprentice weight allowance if applicable, total jockey's weight, equipment used:
 - b - blinkers
 - f - front bandages, odds
- (P)** Top 3 finishers with distance ahead of next horse.
- (P)** Trouble Line - added insight into the race.

Early Pace Figures (EPFs)

Are basically the horses 'speed rating' at the 1st call of the race. Based on the horse's actual time and other conditions, such as track condition, these figures allow you to compare a horse's performance at the early point of call to see which have been performing best.

Speed Ratings (SR)

Tell you how fast a horse has been running in its recent races. It is based on the horse's actual time and other factors, such as the condition of the track. A horse who races in a top stakes race might earn a SR of 100 for an excellent performance, while an entry racing in a \$10,000 claiming race might earn a 60 for an average performance. All TrackMaster ratings have been equalized for different tracks, distances and conditions, therefore a horse that runs consistently in the 80s at Laurel Race Course should be competitive with horses that run in the 80s at Philadelphia Park.
